Our church follows the historic and widespread Christian practice of closed Communion. We ask that only members of Crown of Life or another congregation of the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS) or Evangelical Lutheran Synod (ELS) partake of the sacrament. We follow this practice because the Bible teaches it and because we love you. Please speak with the Pastor if you have any questions.

Words of Institution

M: Our Lord Jesus Christ, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Then he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you, this is my blood of the new covenant, which is poured out for you for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."


