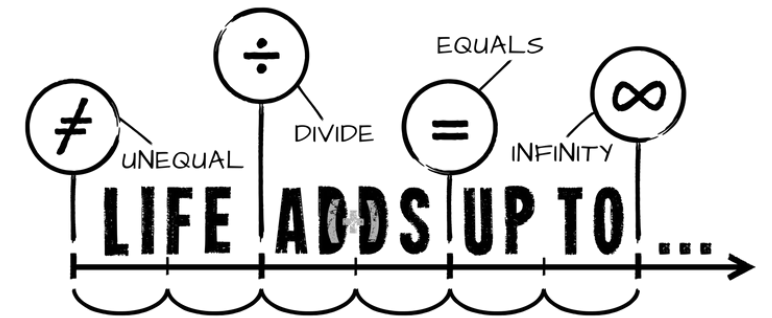
In Christ alone who took on flesh
